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Varda in L' Opéra Mouffe offers a cinematographic variant of the concept of public space. The complexities of street life are reconstructed through simplification and fragmentation for widelenses. Public space is reduced to a single element, a single figure, a single portrayal. The connections made between the eye of the camera which perceives objects, gestures, and the succinct presentation of anonymous characters on the street opens the possibility to investigate thepublic space through ethics. This type of investigation is proposed by this article to understand thenon-aggressive mechanisms of communication and ethics of the public space which Vardasuggests in her work.
